Mayor Rook called the meeting to order at 1:30 P.M.

Mayor Rook welcomed Wiikwemkoong Unceded Territory Council members to the Bi-Annual Meeting.

The following items were discussed:

- A joint program for Community Emergency Management (CEMC) assistance.
- Work with other areas regarding environmental and possible nuclear threats due to the present political atmosphere.
- Emergency management would be another possible program and an inventory of both areas would be necessary for evaluation of possible support.
- Chief Peltier provided an update on the islands negotiations. The Federal government has returned to the negotiation table and the Province's consultations on the environmental draft have had the deadline extended. Once the Ministry of Environment has signed off, then Wiikwemkoong will hold a referendum to complete the agreement.
The Chief advised they remain in contact with the Cottage Associations and are making progress.
- The museum was discussed and Chief Peltier suggested they could provide a letter of support if the municipality required assistance with the grant requirements.
- Several ventures were discussed including the Killarney 200th Celebration in 2020 and 2018 boating regatta.

- War Veteran's Display - Does Wiikwemkoong have any war veteran pictures, medals and any other memorabilia for the display.
- Councillor Reider asked about the Pointe Grondine residents garbage issues. The Superintendent and Deputy-Clerk Treasurer updated on the Certificate of Approval (C of A) and the Municipality is responsible to the Ministry of Environment for compliance.
- Discussed ideas for a ferry service for people and vehicles from Manitoulin Island to Killarney.
Wiikwemkoong will provide a copy of a prior report on the subject.

Chief Peltier thanked the Municipality for the invitation and the input by all to help generate a better environment for all. Next meeting to be held in the Spring of 2018.
