### Please Continue To Practice Social/Physical Distancing

This means keeping a physical distance of 2 metres between ourselves and others when out and about and wearing a mask when distancing is a challenge. It is recommended that you have close contact only with those people in your household. It is the law that you must quarantine for 14 days if you have returned to Canada from out of country, or if you have come in contact with someone who has tested positive for Covid-19, even if you are not showing symptoms. Gatherings of more than 50 people indoors and 100 people outdoors are restricted. Distancing in gatherings is still required. Again, if distancing is a challenge, a face covering must be worn. Please wash your hands often or use hand sanitizer if washing is not possible. Face coverings are required in all retail stores and enclosed public spaces.

## Fall Fire Safety Tip

Check all smoke and carbon monoxide detectors to make sure they work, and install new batteries. It is the law for all Ontario homes to have a working smoke alarm on every story and outside all sleeping areas. This includes single family, semi-detached and town homes, whether owner-occupied or rented.

Wood burning stoves and fire places should be examined and the flue and chimney checked for creosote buildup .

Always have a charged fire extinguisher available.

## Wildfire Community Preparedness Day

The Municipality has received a \$500 award through the FireSmart program for a one day event that will provide wildfire safety education and practical mitigation assistance to property owners.

### FireSmart Update

The community FireSmart presentation and video are available to view on the Municipality's website. At this time no workshops are scheduled, however the online information provides tips and simple steps that can be taken by property owners to reduce the risk of personal property loss in the event of a Wildfire.

The Government of Canada announced a one-time \$600 payment in recognition of the extraordinary expenses faced by persons with disabilities during the COVID-19 pandemic.
