## THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF KILLARNEY

### BY-LAW NO. 2015-22

# BEING A BY-LAW TO PERMIT THE OPERATION OF OFF-ROAD VEHICLES ON ANY HIGHWAY WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY THAT IS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY, OR ON ANY PART OR PARTS OF SUCH HIGHWAYS

**WHEREAS** the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, Section 191.8 (1) Chapter H.8 as amended, states no person shall drive an off-road vehicle on a highway except in accordance with the regulations and any applicable municipal By-Laws;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 191.8 (3) (a) of the Highway Traffic Act R.S.O. 1990 Chapter H.8 as amended, states that the Council of a municipality may pass by-laws permitting the operation of off-road vehicles with three or more wheels on any highway within the municipality that is under the jurisdiction of the municipality, or on any part or parts of such highway;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 4 (2) of Ontario Regulation 316/03 states that all-terrain vehicles, multi-purpose off-highway utility vehicles and recreational off-highway vehicles may be driven on a highway if the requirements of Part III are met;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Killarney enacts as follows:

### **PART I – SHORT TITLE**

1. This By-Law may be cited as the "Off-Road Vehicle By-Law"

### PART II – DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATION

- 2. In this By-Law:
  - **"Municipality"** means the Corporation of The Municipality of Killarney;
  - "Council" means the elected Council for the Municipality;
  - "All-terrain vehicle" means an off-road vehicle that:
  - (a) has four or more wheels, the tires of which are all in contact with the ground;
  - (b) has steering handlebars;
  - (c) has a seat that is designed to be straddled by the driver; and
  - (d) is designed to carry:
    - (i) a driver only and no passengers; or
    - (ii) a driver and only one passenger, if the vehicle,
      - (a) has one passenger seat that is designed to be straddled by the passenger while sitting facing forward behind the driver; and
      - (b) is equipped with foot rests for the passengers that are separate from the foot rests for the driver.

- "Multi-purpose off-highway utility vehicle" means an off-road vehicle that:
  - (a) has four or more wheels, the tires of which are all in contact with the ground;
  - (b) has a steering wheel for steering control;
  - (c) has seats that are not designed to be straddled; and
  - (d) has a minimum cargo capacity of 159 kilograms.
- "Off-road vehicle" means a vehicle propelled or driven otherwise than by muscular power or wind and designed to travel:
  - (a) on not more than three wheels; or
  - (b) on more than three wheels and being of a prescribed class of vehicle.

### "Recreational off-highway vehicle" means an off-road vehicle that:

- (a) has four or more wheels, the tires of which are all in contact with the ground;
- (b) has a steering wheel for steering control;
- (c) has seats that are not designed to be straddled; and
- (d) has an engine displacement equal to or less than 1,000 cubic centimetres.

### **PART III – GENERAL PROVISIONS**

3.1 For the purpose of this By-Law, off-road vehicles shall mean all-terrain vehicles, multi-purpose off-highway utility vehicles and recreational off-highway vehicles as per the following definition and are the only types of off-road vehicles permitted on Municipal highways and roads.

### PART IV – OPERATION OF OFF-ROAD VEHICLE/MAXIMUM SPEED

- 4.1 Every person operating an off-road vehicle within the Municipality of Killarney shall comply with the provisions prescribed by the Ontario Regulation 316/03: Operation of Off-Road Vehicles on Highways and the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. H.8.
- 4.2 The off-road vehicle shall not be driven at a rate of speed greater than:
  (a) 20 kilometres per hour, if the speed limit established under the Act for that part of the highway is not greater than 50 kilometres per hour, or
  - (b) 50 kilometres per hour, if the speed limit established under the Act for that part of the highway is greater than 50 kilometres per hour, O. Reg. 316/03, s.22.

### **PART V – EXCEPTIONS**

5.1 No person shall operate an off-road vehicle over or upon the following areas listed in Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this By-Law.

### **PART VI – ENFORCEMENT**

6.1 Any person who contravenes any provisions of this By-Law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to a fine as provided for under the Highway Traffic Act and the Compulsory Automobile Insurance Act.

### **PART VII – SEVERABILITY**

7.1 Should a court of competent jurisdiction declare a part or whole of any provision of this By-Law to be invalid or of no force and effect, the provision or part is deemed severable from this By-Law, and it is the intention of Council that the remainder survive and be applied and enforced in accordance with its terms to the extent possible under law.

### **PART VIII - SCHEDULES**

8.1 Schedule "A" shall be deemed to form part of this By-Law.

### **PART IX – AUTHORITY**

- 9.1 By-Law 2004-11 and 2012-10 are hereby repealed.
- 9.2 This By-Law shall come into force and take effect on the day it is passed.
