Call for Committee Members!

The Municipality of Killarney is seeking members of the community to join the Property Standards Committee.

What are Property Standards and what is the Property Standards Committee?

The Municipality of Killarney has a Property Standards By-law which sets out the minimum standards for buildings and property maintenance within the Municipality. Standards prescribed in these by-laws are intended to outline the reasonable maintenance and upkeep of yards, buildings and properties.

If a complaint is received for a property that does not conform to the by-law, a Property Standards Officer will conduct an investigation to determine if the property meets the provisions as set out in the by-law. If the property violates the by-law, an Order to Comply may be issued requiring the landowner to make any necessary changes or fixes to adhere with the regulations. The Property Owner does have a right to appeal an Order.

The Property Standards Committee is a quasi-judicial body appointed by Council to consider appeals to Orders issued by Property Standard Officers. It is the Committee's role to make an informal and impartial decision; it has the powers under the Ontario Building Code Act to confirm, modify and rescind the order; to demolish or repair structures, and to extend time for complying with the Order.

Meetings are held as required (as Appeal to Orders are received)
