On March 19, 2020, Bill 187, *Municipal Emergencies Act, 2020* came into force. This legislation amends the *Municipal Act, 2001* to permit municipalities to amend their procedural bylaws to provide that, during emergencies, members of Councils, local boards, and committees who participate in meetings electronically may be counted for the purposes of determining quorum.
