Mayor Rook called meeting to order at 5:20 P.M. and proceeded with roll call, asked if there was any disclosure of interest and read the following statement:

On March 19, 2020, Bill 187, *Municipal Emergencies Act, 2020* came into force. This legislation amends the *Municipal Act, 2001* to permit municipalities to amend their procedural bylaws to provide that, during emergencies, members of Councils, local boards, and committees who participate in meetings electronically may be counted for the purposes of determining quorum. The Municipality of Killarney has decided to make such an amendment to its procedural bylaw in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. Accordingly, meetings of the Municipality's Council, local boards, and committees will be conducted by teleconference. The public will also be able to observe such meetings in the same manner. Further to the COVID-19 pandemic and to promote the health and safety of the public, members of Council and staff, it is hereby the decision of Council that this meeting will be held via teleconference and the meeting will also be recorded. This is further enforced by an Order in Council made under the Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act on March 28, 2020 which prohibits any person from attending an organized public event of more than five people.

The Mayor announced that the only matter of business was a by-law to allow for electronic participation for Council, Local Boards and Committee Meetings.

Note: All motions are recorded votes in order to ensure the public is aware of how councillors are voting since they are unable to view the meeting proceedings.
